

Q. Why would my family want to host the Pilgrim Virgin Statue?

A. People who have hosted the Pilgrim Virgin Statue in the past report receiving abundant graces from the visit. Our Lady, through the Rosary, always brings us closer to Christ.

Q. How long will my family have the statue?

A. The usual visit is one week beginning on a Saturday, but the actual length of the visit is up to you.

Q. What do we do with the statue while it is in our home?

A. The kit that accompanies the statue contains a home visitation program booklet that begins with a welcoming prayer (on page 3), guides you through appropriate Marian prayers, and ends with Mary's farewell (on page 9). You are encouraged to pray and say the Rosary with your family and friends.



Q. Is there a charge for this program?

A. No, there is no charge to have the Pilgrim Virgin Statue visit your home.
